Betty was born the 3rd child of Emick and Anna, in Lafayette, La on August 2nd, 1932. She graduated from Lafayette High School in 1950, where she was active as a cheerleader and excelled in sports. She later moved to Boston, Massachusetts, to marry the love of her life, Joseph Dupuis of Lafayette, while he was serving and stationed in the Navy. After moving back to Lafayette, her husband accepted a position with Sun Oil Company in Maracaibo, Venezuela during the big oil boom in 1957. Betty thrived in her newfound lifestyle and became fluent in Spanish. She learned to cook authentic Latin dishes and enjoyed all the activities afforded her in a country that has endless summers. She learned to play golf along side her husband and enjoyed the many pools and beaches that were prevalent to that area. Their love of travel also brought them to beautiful Caracas and the Andes Mountains. Betty loved the wildlife and Exotic birds of Maracaibo, adopting many parrots who became her beloved pets and friends. Betty and her children lived there from

1957 to 1963 before moving back to Lafayette, Louisiana, to continue raising the family. Betty was very involved in her children's lives helping them in their many sports related activities. She also enjoyed doing volunteer work for the hospitals as a Pink Lady.

Betty was an Exotic beauty and had a great sense of style, from her impeccable taste in fashion to decorating their beautiful home. Her interests were many. She was a fabulous cook, loved to bake and try new recipes. Her skills were in full display during the holidays, but especially at Christmas. Betty loved music of all genres, loved to sing, dance, play the organ and the tambourine. Her love of travel and adventure took her and her family cross country and beyond. She

enjoyed a good laugh and had a great sense of humor. She was also a voracious reader, loved to write and was a relentless advocate for the unborn. Betty joined the Catholic Charismatic Movement in the early 1970's during one of the most exciting Revivals of our time. She traveled nationwide as a leader and guest speaker, sharing her testimony and leading many people to the Lord. In her later years she taught Bible classes, worked with the youth and was an ardent intercessor and prayer warrior. Betty realized her dream of going on a Missionary trip to the Dominican Republic at the age of 79. Her passion for sharing the message of the cross never faltered, even during her lengthy illness. Betty will be remembered as a Powerhouse for the Kingdom of God and that she remained faithful to her beliefs.
