Her dedication to KLFY and her clients over the years made that decision a hard one. But not long after shifted into her new role as grandmother to Ellison Frances Ferrell.

Charlotte was a loving wife, mother, and friend. She brought a light to anyone she met. She had an infectious smile and laugh that could brighten the darkest days. She was loyal to a fault and someone you could always rely on to get things done. In her life and career, she led by example and was supportive to everyone who sought her support and guidance. She was dedicated to family, friends, and coworkers. She would be serious and professional when the time called for it, however, for those who truly knew her, she was a jokester and prankster always looking for a laugh.
